★ Abbreviations ★

Ch – chain
 Sc – single crochet
 Hdc – half double crochet
 Dc – double crochet
 Sc2tog – single crochet two together
[3 dc-cl](#) – three double crochet cluster stitch
 St – stitch
 Rep – repeat

★ Materials ★

Jute yarn
 Green yarn
 Purple yarn
 White yarn
 Orange yarn
 Navy blue yarn
 Fiberfill stuffing
 Dowel or other support
 Tapestry needle
 Pins

★ Jute Patch ★

1) ch 5, turn
 2-3) 4 sc, ch 1, turn – 2 rows
 Finish off

★ Main Body ★

Head and Torso

Starting with jute

1) ch 2, 6 sc in first st – 6
 2) 2 sc in each around – 12
 3) 2 sc in next st, sc, rep – 18
 4) 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, rep – 21
 5) sc in each around
 6) 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, rep – 24
 7-8) sc in each around – 2 rows



- 9) 2 sc in next 8 st, 16 sc – 32
- 10-13) sc in each around – 4 rows
- 14) Sc2tog 8xs, 16 sc – 24
- 15) Sc2tog, 2 sc – 18

Stuff head

- 16) sc2tog, sc, rep – 12
- 17) sc2tog around – 6
- 18-19) sc in each around – 2 rows

Switch to off-white

- 20) 2 sc in next st, sc, rep – 9
- 21) 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, rep – 12

Switch to green

- 22) 2 sc in next st, sc, rep – 18
- 23) 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, rep – 21
- 24-28) sc in each around – 5 rows

Insert wooden dowel

- 29) sc2tog, 6 sc, rep – 18
- 30-34) sc in each around – 5 rows

Switch to navy blue

- 35-38) sc in each around – 4 rows

Leg 1

- 39) 6 sc, skip next 9 st, 3 sc – 9

Stuff torso

- 40) sc in each around
- 41) sc2tog, 7 sc – 8
- 42-45) sc in each around – 4 rows
- 46) 4 sc, ch 4, skip next 3 st, sc – 9
- 47) 3 sc, sc2tog, 4 sc – 8
- 48) sc in each around

Insert jute patch behind gap in stitches

- 49-53) sc in each around – 5 rows

Stuff leg**Switch back to green**

- 54) 4 sc, in back loops only, 2 sc next 3 st, sc – 11
 - 55) 4 sc, *2 dc next st, dc, rep from * 2xs, sc – 14
 - 56) 6 sc, 2 dc next 5, 3 sc – 19
 - 57) sc in each around
 - 58) 7 sc, ch 1, turn
 - 59-61) 6 sc, ch 1, turn – 3 rows
 - 62) fold in half, sl st through two sets of loops and around entire bottom of shoe
- Finish off.

★Leg 2★**Start in first skipped stitch with navy blue**

- 1) 6 sc, skip next 9 st, 3 sc – 9
- 2) sc in each around
- 3) sc2tog, 7 sc – 8

4-14) sc in each around – 11 rows

Stuff leg

Switch to green

15) 4 sc, in back loops only, 2 sc next 3 st, sc – 11

16) 4 sc, *2 dc next st, dc, rep from * two times, sc – 14

17) 6 sc, 2 dc next 5, 3 sc – 19

18) sc in each around

19) 7 sc, ch 1, turn

20-22) 6 sc, ch 1, turn – 3 rows

23) fold in half, sl st through two sets of loops and around entire bottom of shoe

Finish off.

★Tongue of Shoe (Make 2)★

In green

1) ch 5, turn

2) 4 sc, ch 1, turn

3) 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st – 6

Finish off. Sew to top edge of green sneakers.

★Arms (Make 2)★

Start with jute

1) ch 2, 5 sc in first st – 5

2-3) sc in each around – 2 rows

4) 2 sc, 3 dc-cl, 2 sc – 5

Stuff hand

5) Sc, sc2tog, 2 sc – 4

Switch to white

6-7) sc in each around – 2 rows

8) 2 sc in next st, sc, rep – 6

9-14) sc in each around – 6 rows

Stuff arm

15) sc2tog, 4 sc – 5

16) sc in each around

Switch to green

17-20) sc in each around – 4 rows

21) sc, ch 1, turn

22) fold in half and sc through 2 sets of loops, ch 1, turn – 3

23) sc in each

Finish off. Sew on either side of body, thumbs facing outwards.

★ Hair ★

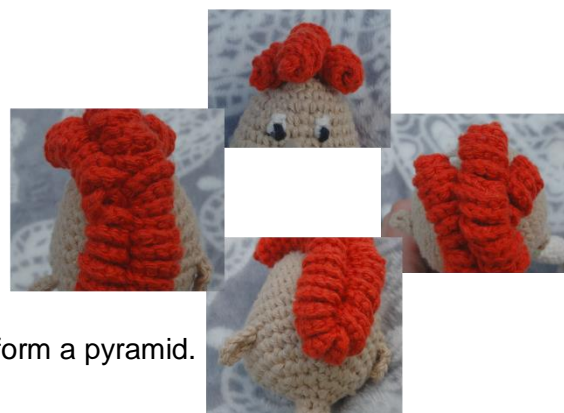
All in orange

Center piece

1) ch 126, turn
2) 4 sc in each st
Finish off. Fold almost in half and sew together.

Side piece

1) ch 13, turn
2) 4 sc in each st.
Finish off. Sew to upper part of centerpiece so the three ends form a pyramid.



★ Earlobes (Make 2) ★

In jute

1) ch 8, sl st to join
Finish off. Sew on either side of head near the bottom..

★ Nose ★

In jute

1) ch 2, turn
2) 3 dc-cl in first st
Finish off. Sew to center of face.

★ Embroidered Details ★

Sneakers

In navy blue

Sew three straight lines across top of shoes.

Snake on T-shirt

In purple

Sew basic shape of snake (lightning bolt). Wrap around strings to thicken and neaten.

In white

Sew eye for snake where lines for snake's mouth diverge.

In navy blue

Sew line down center of snake's eye

Facial Features

In white

On either side of nose, sew squares of white.

In navy blue

Beginning in middle of each eye, sew a line down the center.

Below nose, sew a half-smile/smirk. Go over with yarn to add thickness.
